Thomley Hall	£650	Broader experience of a range of sports and activities offered in a therapeutic setting	Primary students attend Thomley hall during the year where they have experienced Go-Karting, soft play, cycling, swings and the sensory room.
PE support	£3368	Increase knowledge and skills of staff in teaching PE & Sport	We used a qualified PE teacher to teach twice per term to pupils. He also provided support with planning and practical activities to staff to enable them to enhance their ability to teach skills in PE & Sport
